### 2025 – Registration Date

Registrations will be open on-line from **4<sup>th</sup> January 2025**.

The registrations for 2025 will be via PlayHQ ([www.playhq.com/netball-australia](http://www.playhq.com/netball-australia)) – there will be a link to this site on our website and social media platforms.

Players will need to register using an email address and all registration fees must be paid in full at the time of registering by debit or credit card. For 2025 there is an option for paying in installments on PlayHQ.

Every player must register online **by Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February** to secure their place in a team. Any online registrations received after this date will be subject to team availability and confirmed only via email.

New Players will need to register online as well as attend our registration day at Wests Illawarra Leagues Club on **Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February, 10am to 2pm** to bring along proof of identity eg birth certificate, passport etc and to try on uniforms.

## Competition

The first competition game for **ALL** players will be **Saturday 5<sup>h</sup> April**. All games for this round will be played at Fred Finch Park Berkeley.

There are game time changes for 2025 will be 8am, 9.15am, 10.35am, 12pm, 1.35pm, 3.10pm.

### **Uniforms**

### **Training**

All training will be held at Fred Finch Park, Berkeley on Wednesdays, including Net Set Go Competition starting from 4pm. Times may vary depending on coach availability.

At all training sessions please come appropriately dressed in joggers, full T-shirts and shorts/tights/tracksuit pants/netball skirts/school sports uniforms.

### **Umpires**

Umpiring is also another area where we are always looking for new young players who are interested in learning umpiring. Please contact the club via email if you are interested.

First time umpires are required to sit the "Rules of Netball Theory Examination" online and attend a Level 1 Umpires Accreditation Course as well as attending on court training sessions.

There will be a compulsory day for all umpires on **Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> March** from 9am till 3pm at Berkeley Netball Courts.

## **Coaching**

Each year we need volunteers to assist with coaching of teams. Without coaches for teams, we are unable to register them to play within the Illawarra competition.
